WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM PROVIDE?

- Five 75-minute classroom visits from a Dairy in the Classroom educator
- Variety of fun hands-on activities related to cows, dairy farming, and the production of dairy products
- Field trip to a cow-based dairy farm
- Grant provides \$200 per classroom to cover field trip expenses

TIMING OF THE PROGRAM?

- Choice of 1 of 3 sessions:
 - early spring 2018 (March –April)
 - late spring 2018 (May-June)
 - fall 2018 (September-November)



WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

- Any PK-3rd grade teacher in a Vermont school
- Schools must currently participate or enroll in Fuel Up to Play 60 and participate in the National School Lunch program
